## DESIRED VOLUNTEER ROLES

Select your preferred position(s) and shift from the following list.

- Friday 24th February - erect barrier mesh on concert fencing (reasonable level of physical fitness required)
- Saturday 25th February, 3pm to 7pm - Ticket scanning
- Saturday 25th February, 3.30pm to 8pm - Merchandise sales
- Sunday 26th February - remove barrier mesh from concert fencing (reasonable level of physical fitness required)
- Sunday 26th February - pack down and clean up of Green Room

Shifts less than 7 hours will receive a festival pass and hat. 7-hour shifts (or more if multiple shifts) you will receive a festival pass, hat and tee.

If you chose a 7 hour shift, or multiple shifts that exceed 7 hours please advise your t-shirt size (unisex sizes):

## **VOLUNTEER TERMS & CONDITIONS - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

As a volunteer for Rock the Ranges, the following terms and conditions must be agreed to:

- Volunteers who have committed to a volunteer shift less than 7 hours will receive a festival pass and hat
- Volunteers who have committed to one 7-hour shift or more if multiple shifts will receive a festival pass, tee and hat
- Volunteers who have selected to scan tickets may need to use their own phone to scan tickets (iPhone)
- Set-up and pack up volunteers may be requested to set out and pack up tables, chairs, bins, minor cleaning, run errands, put up signage and banners at the direction of the Event Crew Member
- No financial payment will be made by Revive the Regions with Music for your volunteer services
- Volunteers must be over 18 years of age at the time of the festival
- Volunteers must complete the tasks assigned as outlined by the festival Volunteer Manager or any other festival staff member
- The festival's Public Liability Insurance will cover you for the duration of your volunteer shift only
- Should you become injured while undertaking your designated volunteer duties there will be limited cover in place under the festival's Voluntary Workers Insurance Policy
- Any accidents or injuries must be reported immediately to your supervisor. If an ambulance is required to transport you, there may be costs incurred for this if you are not a member of an appropriate fund. In case of an accident occurring the festival may call an Ambulance or Doctor and notify your emergency contact
- You must let us know of any medical condition which could affect your duties as allocated prior to commencing your shift
- You must adhere to the ticketing terms and conditions of entry listed on the festival website
- You agree to organise and pay for your own food and accommodation
- You agree to take care of your personal belongings. While there will be a place to store your things during your shift, the festival will not be held responsible for any valuables that are lost or stolen
- Anyone found to be under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances during their shift will have their pass immediately revoked
- Any volunteer who fails to honour their volunteer commitments without a valid reason will have their pass revoked and any future applications will not be considered
